
This clock exemplifies the statement "beauty in simplicity". This mid 19th century Austrian Vienna regulator is of the Biedermeier style. The graceful curves and straight lines of the rosewood case are nothing short of elegant. The dial of the clock is enamel with Roman numerals signifying the hours. The dial of the clock is enclosed in a beautifully detailed cast brass bezel. Time is indicated via the hand cut steel hands. All one need s to do to keep this amazing timepiece running is wind the weight driven movement once a week.



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
